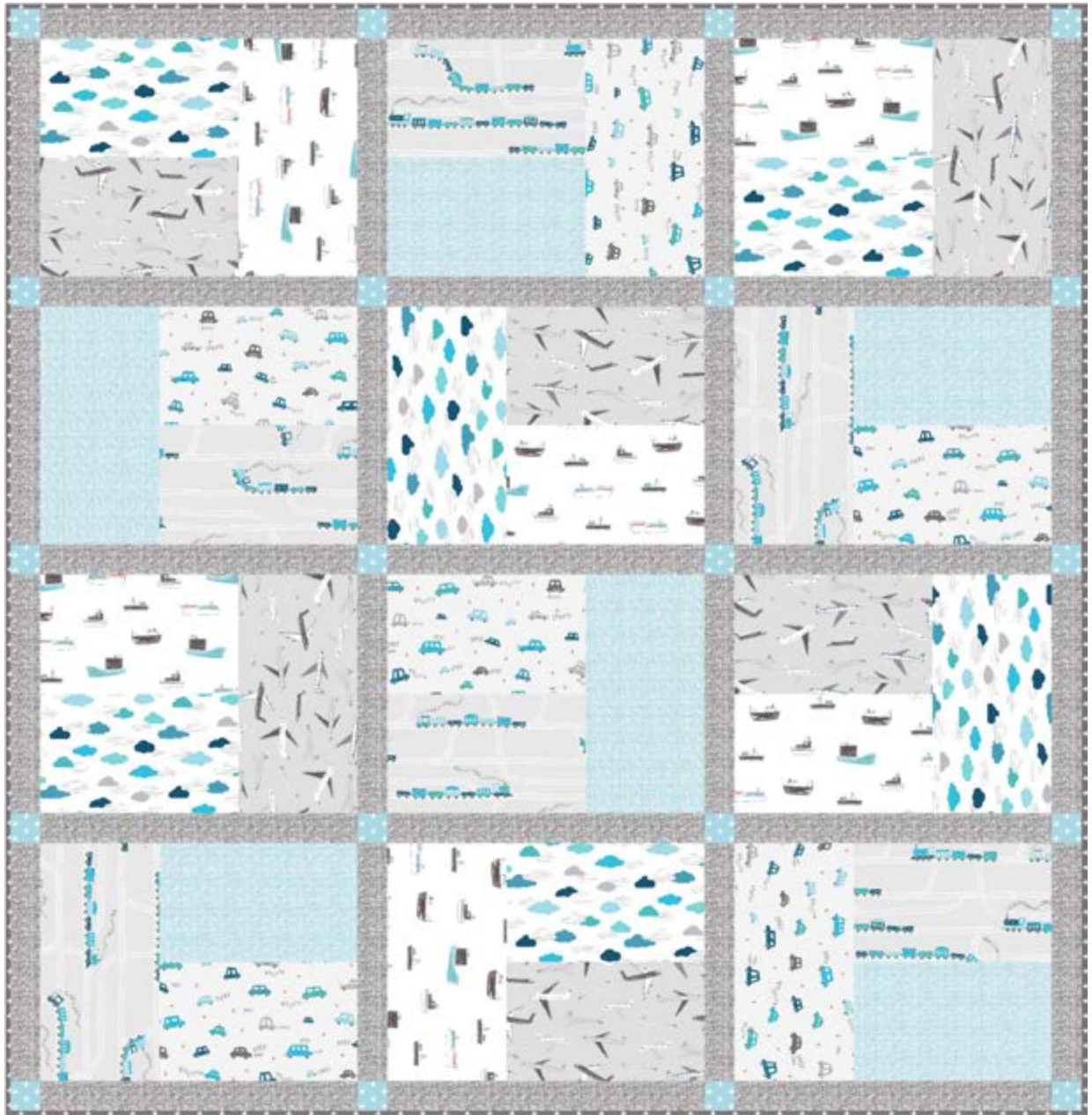

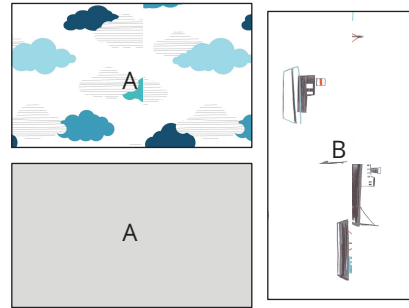
# PICTURE PERFECT QUILT PATTERN

Materials and Cutting		
Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
 Net Stella-370 Ash	1 yard	Cut 1 strip, 12 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x wof (width of fabric). Sub-cut 16 rectangles, 2" x 12 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> ", for short sashing strips. Cut 1 strip, 16 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x wof. Sub-cut 15 rectangles, 2" x 16 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> ", for long sashing strips.
 Take Flight Stella-615 Multi	1/2 yard <i>each</i>	From <i>each</i> fabric, cut: Two strips, 6 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x wof. Sub-cut 4 <b>A</b> rectangles, 6 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 10 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> ", and 2 <b>B</b> rectangles, 6 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> " x 12 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> ".

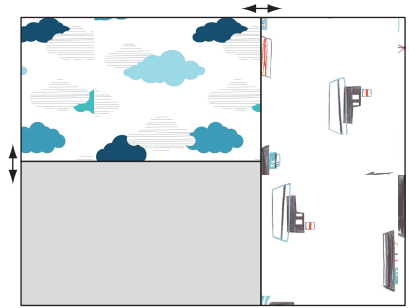
Note: All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise specified. Press the seam allowances as indicated.

### Make the Blocks

1 Referring to the photo for fabric placement, select 2 **A** and 1 **B** rectangles. Arrange the rectangles as shown.

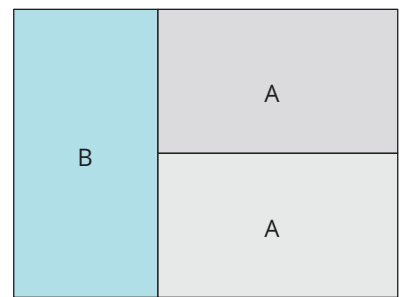


2 Join the two **A** rectangles along adjacent long edges. Press the seam open. Sew the **B** rectangle to the right edge of the joined **A** patches. Press the seam open. Make a total of 6 blocks for rows 1 and 3.



**Row 1-3 Block**  
Make 6.

3 Repeat steps 1 and 2, placing the **B** rectangles to the left of the joined **A** patches. Make a total of 6 blocks for rows 2 and 4.



**Row 2-4 Block**  
Make 6.



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# PICTURE PERFECT QUILT PATTERN

## Quilt Assembly

1 Referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram, arrange the blocks in four rows of three blocks each. Place one short sashing strip at each end and between the blocks in each row. Sew the blocks and sashing strips in each row together along adjacent edges. Press the seams open.

2 Arrange four cornerstones and three long sashing strips in a sashing row as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Join the cornerstones and strips

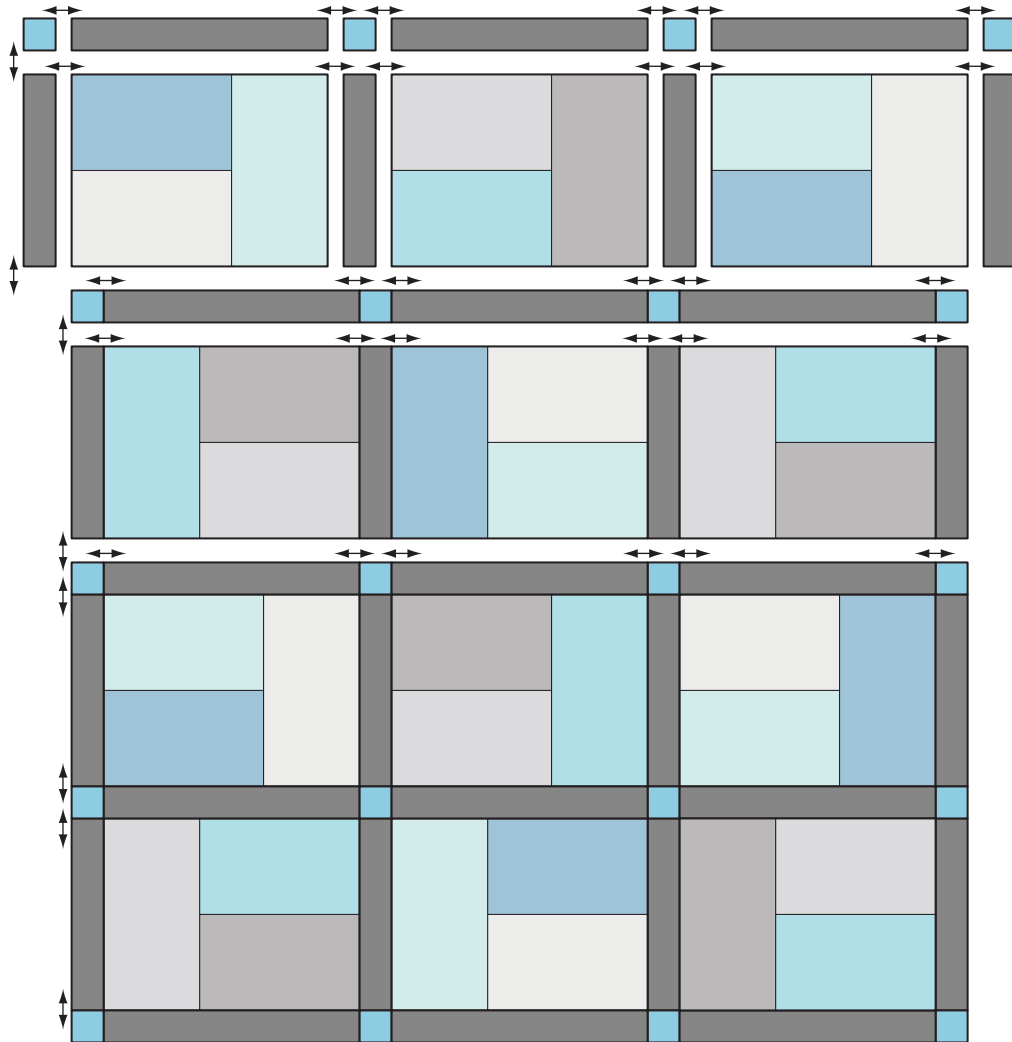
together along adjacent edges. Press the seams open. Make 5 sashing rows.

3 Join the block rows and sashing rows together along adjacent edges, matching seamlines, to complete the quilt top. Press the seams open.

## Finishing

1 Remove the selvages, then cut the backing fabric into two equal lengths. Sew the two pieces together along one long edge, using a  $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance. Press the seam open.

2 Layer the quilt back, batting and quilt top. Quilt as desired. Stitch around the perimeter of the quilt, a scant  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the edge. Trim the excess fabric and batting. Use your favorite method to bind the quilt.
